

Autopay Mobility System Privacy Policy

Dear User!

We care about your privacy and want you to feel comfortable while using our services.

Therefore, below we provide you with the most important information about the principles of our processing of your personal data under the Autopay Mobility System (the "System"), which consists of the Autopay mobile application (the "Application") and the service together with the Autopay web application, located at <https://app.autopay.eu/> ("Service"). In this document we also present information about cookies that are used by the Service.

This information has been prepared taking into account the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

YOUR RIGHTS

Your data are processed by us for purposes related to the operation of the System and the provision of services offered therein. With respect to processing, you have the right to request:

- access to your personal data, including obtaining a copy of your data (Article 15 of the GDPR or, if applicable, Article 13(1)(f) of the GDPR),

- their rectification (Article 16 of the GDPR),
- their deletion (Article 17 of the GDPR),
- restriction of processing (Article 18 of the GDPR),
- request the transfer of data to another controller (Article 20 of the GDPR).

As well as the right:

- to object at any time to the processing of your data:
 - for reasons related to your particular situation - against the processing of personal data concerning you based on Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR (i.e. on the legitimate interests pursued by us), including profiling (Article 21(1) of the GDPR);
 - if personal data are processed for the purposes of direct marketing, including profiling, to the extent that the processing is related to such direct marketing (Article 21(2) of the GDPR).

You can object to our use of cookies (which you can read about below), in particular by using the widget available at the bottom left corner of the Website page and in the banner displayed when you first visit the Website, or by using the appropriate browser settings.

In addition, if you want to delete your account in our System, you can do so through the Application using the dedicated function.

If you believe that your data are being processed illegally, you can file a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Authority.

What happens if I don't provide the data?

Sending marketing information, especially special offers

On what basis?

Your consent to our marketing activities (Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR)

How long?

Until you withdraw your consent - remember, you can withdraw your consent at any time. Data processing remains lawful until you revoke your consent.

In addition, your data will be processed until the period in which claims can be asserted - by you or us - has expired.

For what purpose?

Adapting our services to the needs of our Users, as well as improving the quality of these services

On what basis?

Our legitimate interest in processing your data for the purpose of conducting surveys of your satisfaction with our services (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR)

How long?

For the duration of the agreement or until we take into account your objection to the processing*

In addition, your data will be processed until the period in which claims can be asserted - by you or us - has expired.

What happens if I don't provide the data?

We will not take into account your opinion about our services in the work on their further development

9. Taking an action or omission that may give rise to claims related to the System

For what purpose?
Determining, investigating or defending possible claims related to the System

Until the expiration of the statute of limitations for claims or until we take into account your objection to the processing *

ANALYTICAL / STATISTICAL ACTIVITIES

As part of the System and our services, we perform analytical activities to, among other things, make it more intuitive and accessible - as far as you are concerned, this will be done if you allow (e.g. through the widget for managing your cookie preferences or the relevant settings of your browser) such activities. As part of our analysis, we will take into account how you navigate the Website and use the Application - so, for example, how much time you spend on a particular subpage, or which places you click on. Based on such aggregate information obtained from our Users, we can adjust the layout and appearance of the System and the content posted therein to meet the needs of the Users.

If you use our services, based on your usage, we may also conduct statistical activities to measure which groups of Users choose to use our services and how they use the System. Based on such aggregate information, we can make decisions about the direction of our offerings.

PROFILING

As part of the System, we perform profiling - with respect to you, this will take place if you allow (e.g. through the appropriate settings of your browser) such activities.

The profiling we do involves automatically assessing what products or services you may be interested in, using information about the content you view. As a result, advertisements for products or services displayed on the online services you use will be more tailored to you and your needs.

We may also make automatic assessments of what products or services you may be interested in, based on the data you enter into the Autopay app, and target tailored offers to you (where we have a proper legal basis for doing so).

In addition to the above, we may enhance the Autopay application as part of your account to match your preferences, determined automatically based on your past use of the application. Such improvements could include, for example, automatically adjusting the way individual application functions are displayed so that the ones you use most often are more visible to you.

The above-described profiling does not result in decisions that produce legal effects against you or affect you in a similarly significant manner.

DATA SECURITY

When processing your personal data, we use organizational and technical measures in accordance with applicable laws, including the use of SSL certificate connection encryption.

COOKIES

Our Service, like most websites, uses so-called cookies. These files:

- are stored in the memory of your device (computer, phone, etc.);
- do not cause changes in the settings of your device.

As part of the Service, cookies are used for the following purposes:

- remembering your session,
- statistical purposes,
- marketing purposes,
- offering the features of the Service.

Settings	Forever	Memorized user preferences for using the application, e.g. language setting
Facebook	3 months	Used to hold and track visits between pages in order to target advertising, to people who have visited our site
Google Analytics	2 years	Used to analyze how a user uses the site
In the mobile app: Application settings	Until you uninstall the application	Used to remember user settings
In the mobile app: Telephone number	For the duration of the session	In order to improve processes of the application

Using the appropriate options of your browser, you can at any time:

- delete cookies,
- block the use of cookies in the future.

In such cases, we will no longer process them.
